CILTS / Republic Polytechnic Certification Course

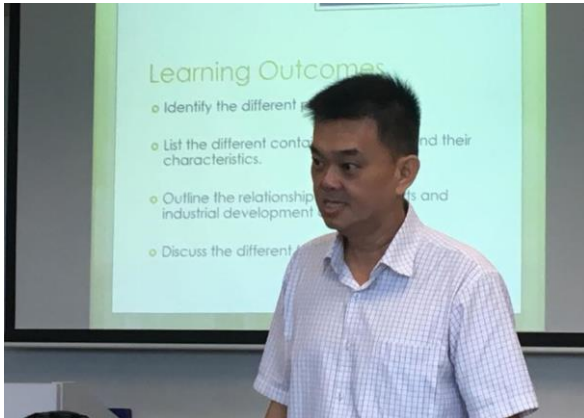

Technical University of Munich (TUM) Asia Harbour Course

For the fourth year running, CILT Singapore conducted the Harbour Course for TUM Asia from 25 February to 5 March 2019. The 5-day programme was conducted at the Singapore Institute of Technology.



University of Hong Kong Master of Arts Transport Planning & Policies (MATPP) Programme

Since 2013, the University of Hong Kong MATPP programme has included a study trip to Singapore for site visits and additional lectures. CILT Singapore has been organising the study trip, which is conducted on a two-yearly basis, in partnership with the University of Hong Kong.

This year, 29 MATPP students were in Singapore from 4 to 6 March for the 3-day programme.

Day 1 saw the group visiting the URA City Gallery, Marina Bay Cruise Centre Singapore and Land Transport Authority SG Mobility Gallery. The group visited the SBS Transit Ulu Pandan Bus Depot and Jurong Port on Day 2. On the third day, the study group from Hong Kong visited the National University of Singapore Advanced Robotics Centre and the Singapore Maritime Gallery.
